Are you a group looking to volunteer? We offer group volunteer packages! Bring your organization out to Zenger Farm for teambuilding and service work.

Zenger Farm thrives on the support of our community. Investing in a team building package is an engaging, hands-on way to connect your brand and employees to Zenger Farm and demonstrate that your company supports food justice. We are uniquely positioned to help make community engagement rewarding and visible for your group.

Benefits include:

- Strengthen your relationship with Zenger Farm, while building team dynamics
- Learn about sustainable farming and food justice concepts and practices
- Connects employees to their local communities
- Creates opportunities for connection and team building
- Strengthens your company's reputation in the community

Zenger Farm works with your group to design one-time or ongoing, service-based team building activities. Our urban farm can accommodate groups of 10-40 volunteers. Group volunteer events are half-day and take place either morning (9am-12pm) or afternoon (1pm-4pm). They begin with a farm tour, followed by a two hour service project. Your team is welcome to reserve indoor or outdoor space to share a meal or conduct a meeting before or after your event. Please reach out to your coordinator to learn more.





Most group volunteer packages require a sliding scale contribution (\$500 minimum) to cover costs and support our mission. We trust that you will pay at the highest rate you are able to. Suggested ranges are as follows:

- Small local company or nonprofit | \$500-\$1,500+
- Medium sized company or large nonprofit | \$1,000-\$3,000+
- Large corporation | \$1,500-\$5,000+
- Mission-aligned partner/culturally specific org | \$0-\$500

Packages include:

- Introductory farm tour and icebreakers
- Guided service activities, which may include seasonal projects like weeding, pruning, tending our gardens, orchard and farm fields, helping maintain our wildlife habitat areas and green landscaping features, etc.
- Opportunities for public recognition via social media and Zenger publications
- Additional site amenities are available, such as indoor or outdoor meeting space
- Optional add-on of Zenger Farm T-Shirt or Hat \$20 per person
